Dear Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2018,

As summer begins, now is the time to start thinking about and planning your student's senior portraits. Acquiring senior portraits is one of our top priorities, and, as a yearbook staff, our goal is to include high-quality portraits for every student.

What are the Shawnee requirements for senior portraits?

Our all-color yearbook is created digitally; therefore, electronic submissions are preferred to ensure high-quality prints.

- 300 dpi (resolution)

Portrait submission deadline:

We prefer head and shoulder shots in which the background and/or props do not distract from the portrait itself (hats are not recommended). All senior pictures must follow Freedom Area High School dress code and be in compliance with the rules of the Freedom Area High School student handbook.

If you prefer to submit your own portrait for your senior:

Please shoot in the highest possible resolution (dpi) on your digital camera. All specifications above still apply. As previously stated, it is our priority to get every senior in the yearbook, and we want to help find ways for that to happen; so, please contact us if you have questions.

One caveat: For the best results, our experience is that you should consider a professional studio for your son or daughter's yearbook portrait. However, if you are not interested in professional portraits, your student is encouraged to have a portrait taken on Picture Day. Even if you are not interested in purchasing photos, this will guarantee a professional portrait for your son or daughter in the 2017-2018 yearbook.
